

Bingo

This classroom activity is great for teaching vocabulary. It works particularly well if there is a big selection of vocabulary.

Beginner: Photocopy 4 or 5 copies of the grid and write in the vocabulary that the students are learning. Then photocopy these 4 or 5 different grids for the students to use.

Lower intermediate: Photocopy enough blank grids for the whole class. Write the desired words on the board. Tell the students to choose 9 words and write them in the squares. (N.B. Some **beginner** students may be able to play this way, dependant on their reading and writing skills.)

How to play:

Pre-prepare some strips of paper with the vocabulary on.

Scrunch up the paper and put it in a cup. Either: call out the vocabulary yourself, or, pick students to pull out a word and read it aloud for the class. As the students hear a word on their sheet, they cross it off the grid.

When a student has 3 words in a row crossed out then they have to call out "BINGO"
