## 10 low-prep activities to break the ice simply

Speak the Alphabet

Say the English alphabet as a class. Only one person can speak at one time. If more than one person says the same letter at the same time, the game restarts.

Find Someone who...

Get your students moving around the classroom and finding similarities between them.

Get your class to learn about each other by interviewing each other and then presenting to the class.

Get your students to warm-up their voices for pronunciation by practicing tongue twisters.

Introduce yourself backwards to your class and get them

Get your students laughing by having them do impressions of famous celebrities.

Simple speaking practice for fine-tuning conversation. Get your students to talk about random topics as a class or in small groups.
